The partnership, established through a rigorous selection process, emphasizes a commitment to quality education. The Partner Organizations have successfully functionalized the schools getting an overwhelming response from the public. The schools in their first 06 months have reached maximum enrollments of over 15,000 students with an unprecedented demand of the parents and children in getting admissions in these People's Schools.

SEF Establishes Professional Development Center (FUTURUM)



On May 9, 2023, the Sindh Education Foundation (SEF) and the Sports & Youth Affairs Department (S&YAD) of the Government of Sindh signed a formal Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to establish a Professional Development Center (PDC) in Karachi. This center is a series of the PDCs that SEF has planned to establish in a meaningful way in different regions.

It expects to play a pivotal role in empowering the youth of Sindh and equipping them with the skills they need to excel in the 21st century.

move towards environmental awareness, the Sindh Education Foundation (SEF) and the Research Development Foundation (RDF) signed a three-year Letter of Understanding (LoU) in Karachi on 18th May 2023. The collaboration aims to promote environmental education in Foundation Assisted Schools in Tando Allahyar, Sanghar, and Sujawal districts. RDF, a non-profit organization, focuses on education, children's well-being, sustainable livelihoods, and climate change in Sindh, Pakistan.

The LoU will implement the Green School Concept, focusing on teacher and student education and empowerment. Activities include establishing Youth Clubs, promoting environmental distributing discourse,

information materials in local languages, and capacity building for teachers. The project will pilot Green spaces with irrigation, install LED lights and solar systems, provide sanitation facilities, and promote waste management with waste bins.

During the signing ceremony, Mr. Abdul Kabir Kazi, Managing Director of SEF, emphasized the Foundation's commitment to grassroots environmental protection, anticipating a lasting impact on climate change in SEF schools and communities. This collaboration signifies a crucial step in cultivating environmental awareness for a greener and more sustainable future in Sindh.

Sindh Education Foundation (SEF) and Taleem Foundation Forge Partnership to Enhance Education Quality

On June 13, 2023, a significant move towards improving education in Sindh, the Sindh Education Foundation (SEF) and Taleem Foundation have joined forces to enhance the quality of education and deploy educational technologies for the enrollment and retention of Out-of-School Children (OOSC) in all educational institutions in the province.

The Letter of Understanding (LoU) outlines the collaboration's scope and terms, with a focus on a two-year commitment to promoting education quality through public-private partnerships and projects. The collaboration aims not only to reach and retain OOSC but also to enhance students' learning outcomes by integrating technology into Foundation Assisted Schools.

Key objectives of Taleem Foundation's intervention with SEF include providing uninterrupted digital educational facilities, establishing a low-cost and effective technology setup through Ataleek distant learning mode, and offering academic support through teachers' capacity building.

Roles and responsibilities are defined, with SEF facilitating pilot testing of technology-enabled schooling, while Taleem Foundation takes charge of deploying Ataleeq solutions, initiating pilot projects, and mobilizing resources through potential donors.

The technology service providers, including Foundation, Information Taleem communications technology for education (ICT4E), Verge System, and AR Enterprises, will offer a range of tools such as LED screens, speakers, learning management systems, and real-time monitoring for online classes.

The general provisions of the LoU allow for amendments through mutual agreement,



emphasizing a collaborative approach between SEF and Taleem Foundation. The agreement underscores the comprehensive nature of the collaboration and the mutual commitment to enhancing education quality in Sindh.

The initiative is set to commence with a pilot project in one community school for at least one academic year, showcasing the potential for scaling up the project across all Foundation Assisted Schools. The signatories, through their authorized representatives, have executed the LoU, demonstrating their commitment to the outlined terms and conditions.

SEF and Edkasa Unleash Educational **Transformation:** A Digital Learning Revolution



The Sindh Education Foundation (SFF) and Edkasa, Pakistan's fastest-growing ed-tech platform, have joined forces to provide digital learning scholarships for students in grades 9-12. Under the terms of the Letter of Understanding (LOU) signed on May 11, 2023, Edkasa will offer free access to its educational platform for SEF schools over the next three years. The non-commercial partnership aims to benefit at least 10,000 students, fostering education through the Edkasa app on Android and IOS. For this purpose, both parties will appoint focal persons for efficient coordination, engage in promotional activities, and collaborate on program implementation. This initiative underscores the commitment to advancing education through innovative digital solutions.

This initiative follows the primary training conducted for 2606 Head Teachers in 2022.

The journey began with a two-day Training of Trainers (ToT) session in Hyderabad on February 17-18, 2023. Key stakeholders, including the Director of Training and Assessment, Ms Sara Murtaza; the Deputy Director Programs, Mr Mukhtiyar Chandio, the Deputy Director of the Training Unit Ms Musarat Palijo; Regional Heads and 44 Master Trainers, came together to drive

this initiative. The training content was subsequently disseminated across districts during each cycle.

The primary goal of this refresher training was to redefine the roles and responsibilities of Head Teachers by enhancing their capacity. The key focus areas included school leadership, observation and feedback mechanisms, in-house capacity building, school record management, and the development and assessment of academic materials.

This refresher program not only realigned roles but also updated experienced and newly appointed Head Teachers. It created an engaging and experientially rich learning environment. This strategic intervention ensures that education management in the region continues to evolve and improve.
